

## SEC Receives Order for Large Horsepower Units

SEC Energy Products is pleased to announce that it is one of the first packagers in the United States to receive an order to build packages using Caterpillar's CM34 engine series. The order is for ten Caterpillar G16CM34 engines rated at 8000 horsepower, and four Caterpillar G12CM34 engines rated at 6000 horsepower. The units will be packaged for use in pipeline transmission applications. The first engines of the order are scheduled for delivery to SEC's Houston production facility in December 2006. The Caterpillar engines are manufactured in Germany.

"This type of order takes SEC to a new level as a packager," says Randy West, one of the partners of SEC. "SEC will be the first to package the large horsepower CAT CM engine line. This really gives SEC an opportunity to showcase its engineering and packaging capabilities and show that it is able to compete with the other major compressor companies."

SEC broke ground on a new 43,000 sq foot expansion to the facility at Fairbanks N Houston shop on May 24, 2006. The shop expansion will add twelve bays to SEC's current production capacity. The expansion was necessary to accommodate the growth of a company that only opened its doors in July of 2003.
